<b>Role</b>	<b>Sorter</b>
<b>Location</b>	One of our Vinnies Centres throughout the Canberra/Goulburn Central Council area
<b>Why we need you</b>	To assist with general duties in our retail Centres with a focus on the task of <b>sorting donations</b> . Sales from Vinnies Centres support people in need within our community.
<b>How you can help</b>	<p>Register your interest to volunteer via our website and kindly state the Centre where you would like to help and the specific role you have an interest in. We will confirm a vacancy or provide alternative opportunities.</p> <p>We will interview you and provide you with training necessary to make your engagement successful.</p> <p>Once you have been trained, you will be able to use your new skills in addition to existing people skills to interact with customers and other workers within the Centre in a fashion that encourages cooperation and effective retail operations.</p> <p>The Centre Manager, staff and other long serving volunteers will help you!</p>
<b>What will you be doing?</b>	<p>Your role will primarily be working as a <b>Sorter</b>, but tasks may also include pricing donations, displaying merchandise, re-stocking, tidying up the Centre, customer service and operating the till, among other tasks generic in retail.</p> <p>Working as a Centre <b>Sorter</b> will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Checking donations are clean and in good repair</b></li><li>• <b>Sorting of fabric items into different categories to meet our quality control standards</b></li><li>• <b>Sorting clothes in preparation for retail display</b></li><li>• <b>Sorting miscellaneous items into various categories</b></li><li>• <b>Cleaning items where required</b></li></ul> <p>Volunteers work closely with the Centre manager, staff and other volunteers in a friendly and helpful work environment.</p>
<b>How much time will you spend?</b>	Flexible days and hours between Monday and Sunday. To make a meaningful contribution, we ask our volunteers to commit at least 3 or more hours a week and for a given period of time no less than three months. More time is welcome.

<b>How we will help you</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Provide you with Society orientation.</li> <li>2. OH&amp;S training &amp; orientation to the Centre tasks, and ongoing support.</li> </ol>
