The Stanmore service has proudly provided employment opportunities for people with varying forms of disability for over 35 years. Ozanam Industries Stanmore employs over 40 supported workers in a supervised, monitored and supportive work environment.

Ozanam Industries has three services across the State and provides a wide array of products and services including sorting and assembling various commercial products for packaging and distribution such as show bags, conference bags and bulk retail items and mail fulfilment and envelope supply.

Over the past year, Ozanam Industries at Stanmore has undergone a significant redevelopment including an entirely new internal fit out. Complete with a new roof, large eating space and balcony, internal elevators and climate control, the service has been transformed into a modern and light filled work space.

The new service shows people with disability that the Society recognises them as valued employees and that they deserve to have excellent conditions of employment. The new space will also optimise opportunities for each employee to develop to their full potential.
