### **St Vincent de Paul Society to conduct a free Wills Day in Ryde**

Many people may not realise that around fifty percent of Australians die intestate, that is, without a valid Will.

Making a Will is often quicker and simpler than people expect and can bring about a profound peace of mind. Delaying putting your affairs in order is risky and worrisome. Depending on a person's circumstances when they die, their estate could end up being distributed according to State laws, or even go to the Crown with their nearest and dearest not receiving anything.

Irrespective of age, everyone should have a Will which is regularly updated to fit with changing circumstances. A current, valid and professionally prepared Will ensures peace of mind that a person's family and loved ones are protected in the future with property and assets are passed on to chosen beneficiaries.
