Killara Women's Refuge to provide transitional housing for families escaping domestic violence

The St Vincent de Paul Society NSW has confirmed that the Killara Women's Refuge will remain open as a transitional housing service for families escaping domestic violence.

The service will also provide ongoing case management to clients living at the property as well as the service's other transitional properties.

The property is currently undergoing minor works to ensure it adheres to best-practice child safety standards.

It is expected that a family, who has already been identified, will move into the property shortly following these minor improvements.

Catherine Carmichael, a St Vincent de Paul Society Special Works Manager says that the Society is committed to providing intensive and specialised services for women and children.
