### **ST VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY SET TO HIRE HUNDREDS OF STAFF IN NSW**

The St Vincent de Paul Society NSW has announced it will hire more than 600 people over the next 2.5 years as part of its role in providing essential National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) transition services.

The Society is partnering with the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) to provide Local Area Coordination to tens of thousands of NDIS participants and their families. This includes community awareness, planning support for participants and plan implementation.

The Society will deliver Local Area Coordination to five NSW districts for the transition period from January 2016 to June 2018. The first phase of staff recruitment will be for the Hunter New England, Central Coast and South Western Sydney districts.

St Vincent de Paul NSW is seeking expressions of interest from people with experience in the disability and community services sector to work in the following roles:

- Team Leaders
- Local Area Coordinators
- Training Coordinators
- District Managers
- Administration Support.
