1. How many people in Australia are experiencing homelessness?

116,427 people in Australia are experiencing homelessness.

2. What percentage of Australians experiencing homelessness live in Queensland?

18% of Australians experiencing homelessness live in Queensland.

3. What are the three types of homelessness?

The three types of homelessness are primary, secondary and tertiary.

4. What are the percentages of males and females experiencing homelessness?

Of all people experiencing homelessness in Australia, 58% are men and 42% are women.

5. How many children under the age of 12 are experiencing homelessness?

15,872 children under the age of 12 are experiencing homelessness.

6. How many Indigenous Australians are experiencing homelessness?

23,437 Indigenous Australians are experiencing homelessness.

7. Why are many Indigenous Australians living in severely overcrowded households?

Many Indigenous Australians are living in severely overcrowded households because there is a shortage of larger culturally appropriate houses that can accommodate kin.

8. What are the disadvantages of living in remote locations?

In remote locations there is often a lack of specialist homelessness services, less workers and substandard housing. All of these things can contribute to severe overcrowding.

9. What are some of the ways that the St Vincent de Paul Society raises money for people experiencing homelessness?

The St Vincent de Paul Society runs a number of fundraising initiatives such as the CEO Sleepout, the Winter Appeal and the Christmas Appeal.
