De Marillac Pathways is a no-cost program which has been designed to support people who have experienced, or are experiencing, the impacts of domestic family violence (DFV) transition into sustainable employment.

Our overarching vision is to see companions having access to support services and employers, to increase their housing stability, to see them be more financially stable, to increase community connectedness, and to decrease the dependence on the person using violence (PUV).

The program assists clients from all walks of lives and ages 16 and up.

THROUGH STRENGTH BASED CASE MANAGEMENT WE CAN HELP WITH

resume/cover letter preparation	interview skills & work etiquette
up to 6 months of post placement support (mentoring, coaching, social and holistic support)	job searching and digital skills
one-on-one reverse marketing and cold calling support to secure local employment	where possible to assist with attaining drivers license
assist with transport costs to work & interviews (go cards top-ups etc)	source and assist with completion of educational pathways e.g. tickets, certificates
assist with clothing for interviews, including PPE once employed	assistance with attaining work experience
