WORKPLACE GIVING?

Through Workplace Giving, employees can support Vinnies Good Works in our local community by nominating to make a regular donation directly from their salary pre-tax. Employers then pay the donation directly to Vinnies Canberra/Goulburn.

Workplace Giving has enormous potential to fund local programs, because it is collective giving, supported by your entire organisation. Everyone giving a little together means more funds for the cause, and greater impact.

IMAGINE WHAT YOUR ORGANISATION CAN DO IN JUST ONE YEAR.

IF 50 EMPLOYEES DONATE JUST \$2 EACH A WEEK

Vinnies can provide warm blankets, a meal and a fresh change of clothes for a person experiencing homelessness every week.

IF 100 EMPLOYEES DONATE JUST \$10 EACH A WEEK

Vinnies can keep two families in their homes each month avoiding eviction.

ABOUT VINNIES

The St Vincent de Paul Society is an international organisation tackling poverty and disadvantage, assisting people in need, and combating social injustice since it was founded in 1833 in Paris, France by a group of young people who wanted to actively engage in addressing social disadvantage.

The Society now operates in more than 150 countries and has over 800,000 volunteer members. There are more than 60,000 volunteers in Australia, of whom around **2,000 work in the ACT and the surrounding region.**

Through our members, volunteers and staff, the St Vincent de Paul Society Canberra/Goulburn has been serving the local community since 1924.

We provide practical frontline support, advocacy, and friendship to the most vulnerable members of our community.

Our objective is to assist any person in need regardless of creed, ethnic or social background, health, gender, or political opinion.



WHY WE HELP

More than 116,000 Australians are homeless on any given night

For every person living on the streets, 13 more experience other forms of homelessness

20% of people experiencing homelessness identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander



Almost 60% of people experiencing homelessness are under the age of 35



42% of clients of specialist homelessness services have experienced family or domestic violence



More than 1 in 8 Australian children live below the poverty line (739,000 children)

JobSeeker provides recipients with \$314 a week, but the median weekly rent in Canberra is \$500 for a unit and \$630 for a house

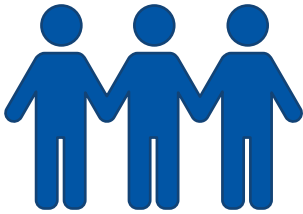
