



Teacher Guide – Picture Prompt

- 1. Distribute pictures and Y chart to each student (alternatively show images on the board).
- 2. Have students look at each picture for 1-2 minutes each. They should be using this time to really look at the pictures in detail (no writing at this stage).
- 3. Once this time is up, students may start filling in the Y chart. It is up to you if you would like them to fill out a separate Y chart for each picture, or to combine their responses in one Y chart.
- 4. LOOKS LIKE What can be seen in the picture? Be specific and go into detail. Students should also identify which type of homelessness is being experienced in the pictures (see fact book 'Types of Homelessness' section).
 SOUNDS LIKE – If you were in the place shown in the picture, what kind of things do you think you would be able to hear?
 FEELS LIKE – For this topic, 'feels like' refers to emotion rather than the sensory 'feels like' of touch. Have students think about the emotions that might be felt by people living in these situations.
- 5. Students share some answers with the group. Students should continue adding to their Y charts if they hear answers that they didn't already have.
