President's Message

As a generous friend of Vinnies, I wanted to inform you of the impact your support has made in our community this past year. If 2020/21 wasn't challenging enough, the last 12 months have presented the Society and our community with a new mix of issues to contend with.

Who knew that we'd have to operate with an ongoing pandemic, cost of living increases, a rise in domestic violence in the community, a crisis in affordable housing, fuel costs for our Night Patrol, an increase in demand across all our services and so much more.

For example, there was a 15% increase in calls to our Helpline, 17% increase for assistance with medical bills, and not surprisingly perhaps, a 22% increase in requests for help with fuel costs.

We provide support, across the Canberra/Goulburn Diocese, from Goulburn to Tumut, from Lake Cargelligo to Merimbula, and Temora across to Batemans Bay.

In all these communities housing, homelessness and related issues, especially affordable and short-term housing is endemic, so your ongoing support is absolutely critical for us to continue to deliver our practical support to those who need it the most, through our services and conferences in these communities.

The people of Canberra and the surrounding region are very generous in their support of us, something we never take for granted. As you'll read in this report, the funds we've raised during the past year have been channelled to where it's needed the most, and you'll see the wide scope and impact of services provided by our members, volunteers and specialist staff to our companions.

Vinnies is out there 365 days and nights a year, giving a practical and compassionate hand up across our region.

Your trust in us and the work we do is an inspiration to our team, and motivates and enables us to do what we do.
